30 "And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength." 31 The second is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these" ~ Mark 12:30-31

Blessed Easter Season to you all! What is wonderful about this time of year is the hope for the spring air, and the anticipation of the changes of new growth that come with that each year. In the church year, we celebrate the Easter season for 50 days that concludes on the day of Pentecost. This year, Pentecost (the giving of the Holy Spirit to Christ's church) is on May 28.

Jesus gives us his greatest commandment here in the passage above from the Gospel of Mark. The passage is found in the midst of Jesus' response to one of the scribes who overheard the Sadducees dispute with one another in the section before (Mark 12:18-27) about the resurrection. The scribe's direct question to Jesus in verse 28, "Which commandment is the most important of all?" Jesus does something that is incredible for us because he sums up the entire 10 commandments in just two related commands.

This leads us to the two parts which Jesus repeats a key word, "all". We are to Love our God with all our hearts, and with all our soul and with all our minds and with all our strength (emphasis mine). What this helps to emphasize for us is that we are to have a single-hearted devotion to God. The other part is that we are to love our neighbor as ourselves. These two commandments together are how Jesus sums up the two tables of the law.

When we think of the 10 commandments, this helps us to see in how God intended for our relationship with Him and with others: Commandments 1-3 Love God and Commandments 4-10 Love people/ neighbor. (see below)

3	Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy	6	You shall not commit adultery

		10	You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, his workers, or his livestock, or anything that is your neighbor's.

As the church, it is important to remember that we can not keep this moral law on our own. God does the work of redemption and guides our heart through the Holy Spirit so that we are able to live this way. When we think of spring time, we see it as a season of growth. During these many weeks of Easter, spend some time to think about how

your rhythms new and old can bring you closer to God and sharing that love that we receive with all those who we meet *and* live next to. Happy Faster!

APRIL 11, 2023 COUNCIL MEETINGS

(Please note that minutes are not approved until voted on by the council at the next meeting.)



The Church Council met on April 11, 2023, at 6:30 PM. Present were Joe Sheldon, Aaron Solomonson, Julie Bentz, Pastor Mann, Kacy Hardt, Chris Albers, Sarah Kadrmas, and Janet Hanson. Absent were Mac Beaudry and Jeff Schmidt. Also present was Jeannette Rost.

The meeting was called to order by Vice-President Joe Sheldon. Kadrmas/Hardt to approve the agenda. Carried.

Pastor led with devotions from the Daily Texts using Psalm 91:9 and 2 Corinthians 1:5.

Solomonson/Albers to approve the minutes from March 7, 2023. Carried.

Solomonson gave the treasurer's report. The following balances are on hand: CD's: \$150,000.00; Checking: \$127,097.70; Building: \$147,234.43; Cemetery: \$617.40; FLY: \$13,517.66; Interest: \$12,190.18; Music: \$734.54; Parking \$1,090.00; Super Sunday Supper: \$4,106.84; \$2,523.44; Ameriprise Worship: Financial: \$39,995.60; Morgan Stanley: \$11,992.40. Total Assets: \$511,100.19. Albers/Hardt to approve the report for future audit and to pay all non-budgeted bills. Carried.

Pastor's report: First Communion was held on Maundy Thursday, April 6, 2023. There were eight communicants. He had numerous visits with members at church, home, phone, and hospital. Pastor will be attending the Eastern South Dakota and Minkota Mission Districts meeting on April 14-15 in Watertown, SD. The Council saw a short video on the overview of the North American Lutheran Church 2020 vision.

Committee reports:

Stewardship-Bentz is sending out thank you's to people who have given their Thrivent Choice dollars.

Worship-No report.

Education-Kadrmas reported the last day of Sunday School will be May 7. They are working on VBS plans. Teachers are being looked for next year's Sunday School.

Evangelism-Prayer warriors have been assigned for the graduates. They are working on a fun kick off for the next year to be held in August.

Property-Albers has been looking for bids for lawn spraying this year. Albers/Solomonson to accept the bid from nitro-green for lawn spraying for the 2023 year. Carried. A request was made to have a removable handrail to go up to the altar for communion. Albers will look into this.

Mutual Ministry-Still working on the decorating decisions. Pastor, Hardt, Hanson, and Sheldon will meet to get some ideas to the Council for next month.

Old Business:

We have \$1,145.92 in Thrivent Choice Dollars.

New Business:

We were asked if we would like to sponsor a Camp of the Cross Summer Sunday Meal. Albers/Bentz to use \$500.00 from Thrivent Choice Dollars to sponsor a Summer Sunday Meal at Camp of the Cross. Carried.

We are in need of new candelabras. The cost will be around \$3,090.00 without the candles. Hardt/ Bentz to use memorial money from the Slagg and Aaseth memorials to purchase new candelabras and candles. Carried.

The next meeting will be on May 10, 2023, at 6:30 pm

The meeting was adjourned by Sheldon.




