Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord. Can you hear the songs of the season? The birds are singing and the warmer weather that we have longed for has arrived. This is also a season of changing plans, going and exploring new and old favorite places. What will the summer have in store where you are going?

Last month, we ventured into Jesus' describing his Greatest Commandment: To Love God and Love People (Neighbor). This month we will be joining Jesus to look at his Great Commission from the last chapter of the Gospel of Matthew. In the opening verses, we see Jesus declaring "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me." This is where Christ is fully exalted and given free use of divine authority.

Our verses above declare to us Jesus' command to do something specific. What is it that he calls every Christian to do? We hear in this command that we are to do three things: make disciples, baptize them in the name of the Trinity (Father, Son and Holy Spirit), and teach them to obey all that He commanded.

We are brought into the family of faith at our baptism. This begins our mission to share this Good News with all who are not yet followers of Jesus. We then can explain this good news and way of Jesus and help others to follow Jesus too. The Holy Spirit helps to guide us in not just adding new disciples of Christ, but he multiplies as He works through the Word.

This ultimately reminds us of the final words of Jesus in this Gospel, which is that He will ALWAYS be with us! We can remember this as we are coming and going this summer and share the Good News of Jesus with everyone.

MAY 10, 2023 COUNCIL MEETINGS

The Church Council met on May 10, 2023, at 6:30 PM. Present were Mac Beaudry, Aaron Solomonson, Julie Bentz, Pastor Mann, Kacy Hardt, Chris Albers, Sarah Kadrmas, Jeff Schmidt, and Janet Hanson. Absent was Joe Sheldon. Also present was Jeannette Rost.

The meeting was called to order by President Mac Beaudry. Kadrmas/Hardt to approve the agenda. Carried.

Pastor led with devotions from Luke 8.

Albers/Bentz to approve the minutes from April 11, 2023. Carried.

Solomonson gave the treasurer's report. The following balances are on hand: CD's: \$150,000.00; Checking: \$131,089.92; Building: \$147,204.43; Cemetery: \$617.40; FLY: \$12,033.67; Interest: \$12,190.18; Music: \$774.54; Parking Lot: \$1,075.00; Super Sunday Supper: \$3,914.43; Worship: \$2,463.44; Ameriprise Financial: \$39,995.60; Morgan Stanley: \$11,992.40. Total Assets: \$513,351.01. Hanson/Hardt to approve the report for future audit and to pay all non-budgeted bills. Carried.

Pastor's report: He had numerous visits with members at church, home, phone, and hospital. Pastor attended the Eastern South Dakota and Minkota Mission Districts meeting on April 14-15 in Watertown, SD. The Candelabras were ordered. They cost \$1905.00/each plus tax. It will take at least 20 weeks for them to come. Pastor is participating in NALC group called First Five. It is a discussion group that meets monthly via zoom and talks are on different topics. He will be taking vacation from May 19-June 2. While he is gone, on May 21 the worship leader will be Pastor Paul Krueger, May 28 Rick Richard will be the worship leader and Pastoral care will be covered by Dennis Ristvedt.

Committee reports:

Stewardship-No report.

Worship-Schmidt reported the Pastor and the organists have meet and planned through August. He has had a few inquiries about using the screen more with the possibility to have the music shown on the screen during services. Schmidt will look into what would need to be done for this.

Education-Kadrmas reported the last day of Sunday School was May 7. They are now moving forward with planning for VBS which will be held on June 14, 21, and 28 from 5-7:30. Registration forms are out.

Evangelism-Hardt reported that Faith night at the Larks is June 19. People can order tickets for that. They are looking at having a form of Church Carnival on Aug. 6. They are working on plans for it. Property-Albers is working on a handrail up to the altar. The parsonage dishwasher has a leak, the blinds downstairs need to be looked at, and there is a need to look at some evergreens in the backyard and one in the front.

Mutual Ministry-Nothing to report.

Old Business:

We have \$645.92 in Thrivent Choice Dollars. There is nothing new with the Lavern Johnson Trust money and the decorating update.

New Business:

The question was asked if we want to do a float for Riverboat Days. We will ask the congregation if there is someone interested in entering one.

Kadrmas/Schmidt to hold our annual picnic on July 12 starting at 5:30 pm. Carried.

Council members were asked if anyone is interested in attending the LCMC gathering in St. Charles, MO from Oct. 1-3, or the NALC convention in Oklahoma City on Aug. 9-11.

Next month we will decide on the 2nd quarter benevolences.

Schmidt/Bentz to approve the following requests: transfer in for Jean Braun from Immanuel Lutheran Church in Wahpeton, ND., and to remove Natasha Peterson from the membership.

The next meeting will be on June 8, 2023, at 6:30 pm.

Schmidt/Hardt to adjourn. Carried.






No Matter how full or empty your arms may have felt this Mother's Day, I see all of you. You deserve to be celebrated more than just one day.
