Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord. Blessings to you this July! The heat of summer is here to stay as we march through the heart of the summer. What does summer remind you of? Family trips, camping, lake trips, fun, swimming, we could go on and on about this wonderful time of year.

Our texts above remind us of an important aspect of our faith lives. What does walking mean in daily life? It usually implies that someone is going somewhere. They are either heading towards something or away from something. There is action. In Scripture, "walk" is a common term that can describe one's life or way of life. Thus, in the verses leading up to our first passage, Moses throughout chapter 5 has reminded the Israelites (God's chosen people) about when God had given them the 10 commandments at Mount Sinai. A key part of this whole section is that the people were wavering in their following of God's commands or way. The ultimate purpose is expressed well in verse 33.

If we look at another translation of verse 33, "You must follow exactly the path that the Lord your God has commanded you, so that you may live" (NRS). This is a more direct way of saying that we are to follow God's way that he wants us to live. This is what is key to having a relationship with God and even in our relationships with one another.

Instruction, obedience and following God's Word are central to helping us navigate in today's world of confusion and being lost through the forest of sin. It drives us to and even back to the narrow pathway that God continues to instruct and call for us to remember and return. May God give us strength to follow his path, to walk in his ways so that we may be encouraged and given hope and endurance through his Holy Word.





Hello July! That sure arrived quickly.


VBS happened in June and we had a great time!!



# LUTHERAN WORLD RELIEF PROJECTS ITEMS NEEDED

When you purchase the following items, please bring them to the quilting closet by September 15th. Thank you for helping out with this much needed project.

#### **SCHOOL KITS:**

- Four 70-sheet notebooks of wide or college ruled paper approximately 8" X 10½"; no loose-leaf paper
- One 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other
- One pencil sharpener large w/catcher
- One blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)
- Five **unsharpened** #2 pencils with erasers; secure together with a rubber band
- Five black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink); secure together with a rubber band
- One box of 16 or 24 crayons
- One 2 1/2" eraser
- One sturdy drawstring backpack-style cloth bag approximately 14" X 17" with shoulder straps (no standard backpacks)

#### **BABY CARE KITS:**

- Two lightweight cotton t-shirts (no Onesies)
- Two long or short sleeved gowns or sleepers (without feet)
- Two receiving blankets, medium-weight cotton or flannel, or crocheted or knitted with lightweight yarn, up to 52" square
- · Four cloth diapers, flat fold preferred
- One jacket, sweater or sweatshirt with a hood, or include a baby cap
- Two pairs of socks
- One hand towel, dark color recommended
- 2 or 3 bath-size bars of gentle soap equaling 8 or 9 oz., any brand, in original wrapping; no mini or hotel size bars.
- Two diaper pins or large safety pins

#### **PERSONAL CARE KITS:**

- One light-weight bath-size towel (between 20" x 40" & 52" x 27"), dark color recommended – need lots
- 2 or 3 bath-size bars of soap equaling 8 to 9 oz., any brand, in original wrapping
- One sturdy comb, remove packaging Big tooth or detangling combs
- One metal nail clippers, remove packaging




