"One generation will praise your name to another..."

Psalm 145:4

Not long ago I attended the anniversary celebration of a little North Dakota Lutheran Church. Begun in 1901, the congregation never grew beyond 100 members. What caught my attention, however, was their history book. In 1901 there were only a handful of families, but as you trace those family names through years, you see the same names again and again. The first generation's children being baptized, then confirmed, then married. Then the second generation's children; baptized, confirmed, married. Then the third generation, then the fourth generation. They didn't have a fancy building or a fancy organ (Actually, they had to crank their organ by hand until 1960!). They seldom had a pastor for more than two years. Never were they in a growing population area --- but to their great credit, generation after generation faithfully passed their own love of the Lord Jesus to their children. It was their priority, as the pages of the history book show!

What is your priority? What are you passing on to your children? What will your next generation look like? We can give our kids all the "toys", but in the end will that really help them? We can pour ourselves into their "sports" or "activities" – and rightfully so, we want to see our kids excel! Yet, what will it have accomplished if that's all they have when they stand before the throne on the last day? The greatest gift that we can give our families – especially our children – is a lasting love for, and a lasting faithfulness to the Lord Jesus.

In the Psalms, King David writes, "One generation will praise your name to another..", meaning, genuine love for God cannot help but to be passed to the next generation. When children see something that gives, genuine meaning, comfort, hope, joy, purpose, security, and peace in their parent's lives, they too will want the same thing for their own lives.

It was a wonderful surprise to see such faithfulness as I looked through the history book that day. It is my prayer that the same will be said of each of us and our families. As children of God, members and friends of First Lutheran Church, let's work together to make it a reality!

#### **SCHOOL KITS:**

- Four 70-sheet notebooks of wide or college ruled paper approximately 8" X 10½"; no loose-leaf paper - Need lots
- One 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other (wooden or hard plastic only)
- One pencil sharpener large w/catcher
- One blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)
- Five **unsharpened** #2 pencils with erasers; secure together with a rubber band
- Five black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink);
   secure together with a rubber band
- One box of 16 or 24 crayons
- One 2 1/2" eraser
- One sturdy drawstring backpack-style cloth bag approximately 14" X 17" with shoulder straps (no standard backpacks)

#### **BABY CARE KITS:**

- Two lightweight cotton t-shirts (no Onesies)
- Two long or short sleeved gowns or sleepers (without feet)

- Two receiving blankets, medium-weight cotton or flannel, or crocheted or knitted with lightweight yarn, up to 52" square
- Four cloth diapers, flat fold preferred
- One jacket, sweater or sweatshirt with a hood, or include a baby cap
- Two pairs of socks
- One hand towel, dark color recommended
- 2 or 3 bath-size bars of gentle soap equaling 8 or 9 oz., any brand, in original wrapping; no mini or hotel size bars.
- Two diaper pins or large safety pins

## Raising Hope Ministry August 2024





Treasurer's Report: Balance is \$7,819.28. All bills are paid.

#### Committee Reports:

Growth: Graduation Tea was held for seven graduates. Brad Sheldon was the speaker. Music provided by Pastor Paul and Jada Vetter. Third grade students will now receive their Bibles a couple of Sundays after Sunday School starts. Confirmation will be held first Sunday in November due to prior conflicts.

- Action: A quilt has been completed for the church carnival. Quilters have been busy working on LWR quilts. Over 200 school bags have been made and some still need to be strung in the near future. Kits will be put together at the Night with the Quilters Service Project on September 26<sup>th</sup>.
- Community: Delivery of Meals on Wheels will be done in September.
- Camp of the Cross: On August 11<sup>th</sup>, the camp will be holding a 70<sup>th</sup> year celebration. Fourteen FLC kids went to camp this summer. The quilt live auction brought in approximately \$10,000. Two quilts were donated by the FLCW quilters for the live auction.
- Kitchen: Discussion was held on keeping the kitchen clean and removing all food after holding an event. Lots of food has been tossed because of spoilage.
- Library: Discussion was held on the library not being used and possible ways of promoting new books, etc.

Carnival on August 4<sup>th</sup>: Discussion held.

Meeting closed with Lord's Prayer.






